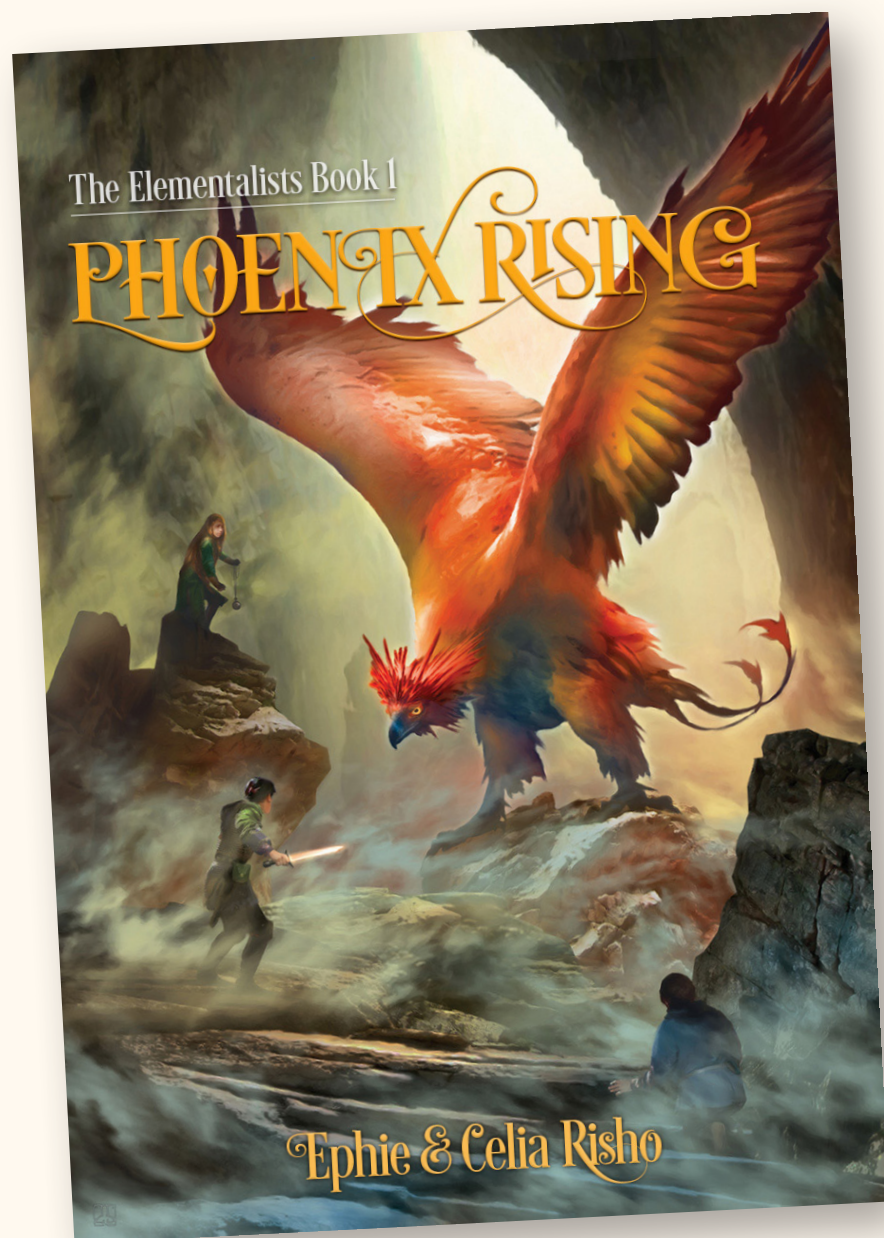


The Elementalist, Book 1
